Reverend and dear Father Turrone,

Thank you for your recent request seeking clarification regarding the normative posture exercised during the celebration of the Holy Mass, as it relates to kneeling and standing.

It is the expected practice in the Archdiocese of Toronto that the faithful kneel at the *Sanctus* until the end of the Eucharistic Prayer, and then stand for the Lord's Prayer and remain standing until the *Agnus Dei*, at which point they kneel and remain kneeling until the time of the distribution of Holy Communion. Once Holy Communion begins to be distributed, they may choose to sit, or kneel, but should not stand in the pew, unless they do so merely while waiting to join the distribution line. Once they return to their seat after having received Holy Communion, they should kneel or sit.

It also the expected practice in the Archdiocese for the faithful to remain sitting during the offertory procession. They should not stand at that time.

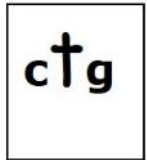
