MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in the Lord:

We are halfway through a relatively mild summer. Things have been rather quiet compared to the previous academic year. Our chapel restoration preliminary work is going along quite well and we hope to begin the physical work by late fall.



A couple of weeks ago, several media outlets inaccurately reported on the Holy Father's instruction regarding communion hosts for celiacs. Some sources reported that celiacs are banned from receiving communion. As a Catholic priest with celiac, I can tell you that this is completely false!

The Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments issued a letter to bishops reiterating *existing* norms regarding the matter of the Eucharist, including the norm that Communion hosts must contain some amount of gluten to be valid matter for consecration. The latest edition of the General Instruction on the Roman Missal, Third Edition from 2011 spells out the reasons for this practice. "Following the example of Christ, the Church has always used bread and wine with water to celebrate the Lord's Supper. The bread for celebrating the Eucharist must be made only from wheat, must be recently made, and, according to the ancient tradition of the Latin Church, must be unleavened." In other words, we cannot modify what God Himself instructed us to do, and what to use when doing it.

This means that celiacs are not banned from receiving Holy Communion. While we cannot receive a gluten-free host, we can receive a very low gluten one. Moreover, parishioners with celiac are welcome to receive the Precious Blood alone if they cannot consume even a tiny amount of gluten (0.1% wheat starch). Please feel free to speak to myself or the main celebrant at least 10 minutes before Mass so that we can make the appropriate preparations as some parishioners have already done. We are pleased to be able to provide low-gluten hosts from an approved source for those who truly require them.
