## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in the Lord:

A small group of us pilgrims just returned from Italy. It was a great moment of fellowship with God, his saints and each other. The first few days of our pilgrimage were spent in Rome where we visited the major basilicas. It was a blessing to have been able to celebrate Mass at the tomb of St. Peter in the Vatican grottoes. We also had the opportunity to be present at the Holy Father's weekly audience. Pope Francis' address to us pilgrims was brief but powerful. Reflecting upon the experience of the disciples on the road to Emmaus, he reminded us that Jesus never leaves us alone. Even when things appear really dark, as they seemed to the disheartened disciples, we can always trust that Jesus is right next to us. Very comforting words indeed!



The second part of the pilgrimage was spent in San Giovanni Rotondo (burial place of St Padre Pio) and at Monte Sant'Angelo (the only place on earth where St. Michael the Archangel has appeared). Life is much quieter in the south than in Rome. We were struck by the endless flow of pilgrims going to pray to Padre Pio. Like St. Francis, he had the gift of the stigmata. His love for Jesus led him to sacrifice himself for the salvation of others. I hope that all of us can do the same.

The third part of the pilgrimage was spent in Assisi and Siena. The endless fragrance of fresh flowers and the sounds of birds chirping makes it easy to understand why many people of all faiths are drawn to this blessed place. Each one of us could feel a deep sense of peace while being there. We visited a place where St. Francis used to pray all night and look up to the sky while crying out that "God is not loved". His greatness was not in his love for trees and animals, but in his unwavering love for Jesus Christ. That is why he, Clare, Padre Pio, Peter and Paul, and Catherine and all the saints are so important for us. May their prayers help us to put God first in our lives as they did, so that we too can one day share in the glory they experience with Him.
