Michael himself explains the meaning behind this great work:

"It is a portrayal of the scene from the fifth chapter of St. Luke's Gospel. My depiction of the first miracle, I have shown the apostles intensely focused on pulling in the net. Jesus stands among them with raised arms, praying for their labours to be overwhelmingly fruitful. His eyes are raised to the heavens as he asks the Father to give the abundant harvest. The miracle is both a literal event and a sign of the Church's mission in the world. I have added many fish swimming beyond the reach of the net, representing the souls who are yet to be evangelized."
