MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in the Lord:

In just a few days I will head up to Ottawa for the 20th annual March for Life with several students from Newman, University of St. Michael's College and Ryerson chaplaincies. Men and women dedicated to the pro-life cause gather together each year to pray and protest peacefully for laws that will uphold the right to life. As Catholics we know that each person, from conception until natural death, must be treated with the upmost dignity and respect because we are all made in the image and likeness of God.



Our Holy Father Pope Francis lamented of these abuses against human dignity during his encounter with diplomats on January 13, 2014 when he said: "Unfortunately, what is thrown away is not only food and dispensable objects, but often human beings themselves, who are discarded as "unnecessary". For example, it is frightful even to think there are children, victims of abortion, who will never see the light of day; children being used as soldiers, abused and killed in armed conflicts; and children being bought and sold in that terrible form of modern slavery which is human trafficking, which is a crime against humanity. Nor can we be unmoved by the tragedies which have forced so many people to flee from famine, violence and oppression."

All Catholic social justice doctrine and practice is founded upon this truth. All effective outreach ministries are inspired and nourished by it. We are blessed to have ShareLife as the official charitable agency of the Archdiocese of Toronto. Through your generous support, various ministries that defend and promote the dignity of the human person are funded. For example, ShareLife helps to provide food, shelter and counselling services to the young, elderly, sick, young single moms and people with special needs. They offer hope and healing to women who have procured an abortion. Furthermore, they share their blessings with people outside of the local community by funding international humanitarian projects in line with Catholic moral teaching. I urge you to continue supporting this important agency through your generous financial contributions.
