## WHAT'S HAPPENING AT NEWMAN

Greetings in the Lord:

Over the past two weeks, the Archdiocese of Toronto held priest conferences on the theme of youth and vocational discernment. The talks re-confirmed our experiences here at Newman Centre. Our youth (and ourselves) are being increasingly influenced, often negatively, by the excessive use of technology and social media. Not only has this led to an over-dependence on technological devices, but it has also shaped the way in which we interact with others. For good or bad, we Catholics are called to utilize these means to reach out to others in an effort to draw them into contact with the Church. Furthermore, this overdependence often leads to excessive levels of anxiety and stress which can make it difficult for them to successfully navigate in a culture which is constantly changing.

For these reasons, many young people are looking for spaces where they can encounter lasting beauty and truth. In a particular way, they are drawn to the solemn celebration of the Holy Mass. This was evident by the fact that many students gave up their Friday evening to attend the Rosary, Mass and Eucharistic Procession on campus on Friday, October 13th. Moreover, there is a deep desire for Eucharistic Adoration. Our Tuesday evening (7:30 - 8:30 pm) and Thursday (12:45 - 1:45 pm) afternoon Holy Hours are a perfect time where one can remain silent while being embraced by the divine presence of our Eucharistic Lord. It is here where one comes to experience the peace promised by Jesus Christ. It is also here that we come to discover our individual calling. Time and time again, people tell me that they come to know how God wants them to serve Him. Recently, a young man told me that he got a very clear sense that the Lord was calling him to consider the priesthood during Adoration.

As our world continues to become faster, louder and busier, the Church is increasingly called to provide beautiful sacred spaces where each person can encounter the Living God through the solemn celebration of the Eucharist and silent prayer before the Eucharistic Lord. God willing, we are also considering having Sung Vespers at least once per week after the chapel restoration is complete.

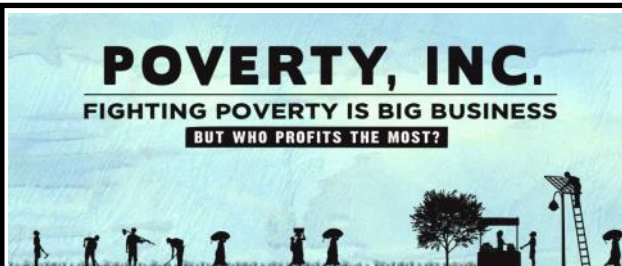

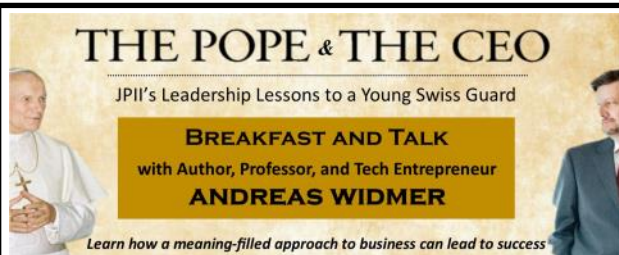
