

In honour of this event, we were privileged to have Mr. Edward Short present on "Newman and the Apostasia" for our annual lecture. One of the statements which struck me was his comment that Newman was deeply aware and concerned over the artificial split between faith and reason. He himself was witnessing the emerging effort on the part of certain secular forces to push the faith out of the public square. Unfortunately, this effort has only increased exponentially in the West over the past few years. This makes our mission at Newman all the more critical. Based on the everincreasing requests for spiritual direction for many students and adults alike, it has become clear to us that many are dissatisfied with what our culture proposes to be the way to happiness. We hope that our Centre will never remain satisfied with what we do, but always grow in our efforts to provide meaningful and relevant "answers for the hope that we have." (Cf. 1 Peter 3:15).

There will be a chapel restoration update in the following bulletin as soon as the permits are issued. If things continue to go as well as they have thus far, we will begin the work sometime in November.




