## Rooted in Community

Students chosen to be part of the Student Campus Ministry team share in a common life that both respects their primary vocation as student, and challenges them to embrace the personal growth that occurs through living closely with others. Students participate in shared meals, communal prayer and formation, and monthly community nights. Each person is encouraged to enter into intentional relationships with other team members in order to build a Christ-centered community that forms the basis for outreach to students, parishioners, and the wider university.

Newman's Student Campus Ministry Team is composed of a maximum of 10 students who are attending any post-secondary education program at any institution in the greater Toronto area, with preference given to those who are attending the University of Toronto. Applications are accepted from those between the ages of 18 and 35, and the team generally has a mix of undergraduate and graduate students. Students live in private rooms, and have a private or shared bathroom. Monthly residence fees includes food, utilities, and access to laundry facilities.

Student Campus Ministry are asked, above all, to come with a spirit of willingness to serve, and a desire to grow in their love of God and others. Through their experiences at Newman, students develop concrete skills that are rooted in a living relationship with Christ and that will help them become leaders in the New Evangelization.



## Living as Disciples of Christ

Student Campus Ministers commit to 12 hours of ministry each week, and assist with Newman's mission in three main ways:

### *Through participation at liturgies*

Campus Ministers assist with daily Mass during the week, as their schedule allows, and help at either the 11 am or 7 pm Mass on Sundays. The connection between our parish community and the weekday chaplaincy efforts is an essential part of our mission, and student campus ministers form an integral link between the weekend and weekday communities.

### *Through contributions to community life*

Student Campus Ministers actively participate in the communal life through regular household duties, as well as through Brother Andre ministry, where they are present one evening a week to assist student groups who meet at the Newman Centre. They also assist with other chaplaincy initiatives as required.


### *Through campus evangelization*

Student Campus Ministers are asked to offer the gifts and talents they bring for the good of others. Team members participate in spreading the Gospel on campus through designing their own weekly ministry, and in other activities such as Pray and Play adoration and board game nights, and weekly Soup and Bagel Lunches.

## Deepening Faith

Ministries carried out through the Newman Centre Catholic Chaplaincy program are rooted in the call to relationship with Christ. Students Campus Ministers are asked to be witnesses of Christ in such a way that their love for God, and their commitment to growing in holiness, flow from them to the rest of the Newman community and beyond.

Beginning with the house orientation training that starts August 20, 2016, and continuing with the ministry orientation retreat over the following weekend, there are many opportunities throughout the year for team members to grow in their spiritual lives. In addition to monthly team formation and frequent access to the Sacraments, students are encouraged to make personal prayer a non-negotiable part of their day. For those applying for the summer term, support is provided in a more informal way, and students can still expect to grow substantially in their faith and to gain concrete skills in service and evangelization.
